**Directions to the Site:**

**From the West:** Take I-90 to Exit 27 (Snoqualmie-North Bend). At stop sign, go left back under the freeway. Road curves to right and downhill. Go approx. 1.2 miles, watch for sign to Snoqualmie Falls and left turn lane shortly thereafter. Turn left at Meadowbrook Way (NOT well marked until after you turn). Continue across Railroad Ave (stop light at SR 202) and continue to Park St. (4-way stop). Turn right, go approx. 0.5 miles, past Snoqualmie Elementary School and Centennial Fields. First field is marked with large Meadowbrook Farm sign and there are two more fields further along on the right. Watch for Lure Trial signs.  
**From the East:** Take I-90 to Exit 31. At end of off-ramp, go right onto SR 202. Stay on SR 202 (Bendigo Blvd.) as it crosses W North Bend Way and turns sharply left. After crossing the river, veer right onto Boalch Ave NW, and continue approx. 1 mile until you see the Lure Trial signs.

## ELIGIBLE BREEDS AND REGISTRY

Only purebred Afghan Hounds, Basenjis, Borzoi, Greyhounds, Ibizan Hounds, Irish Wolfhounds, Italian Greyhounds, Pharaoh Hounds, Rhodesian Ridgebacks, Salukis, Scottish Deerhounds, and Whippets that are one year of age or older and have been registered with The American Kennel Club, or are part of an AKC-registered litter, or otherwise if whelped outside of the USA and owned by a resident of the USA, or of a country with a foreign registry whose pedigrees are acceptable for AKC registration and are registered with that registry, or that have been granted an Indefinite Listing Privilege (IPL) may be entered. Hounds may not be entered as Registration Pending or ILP Pending. Sloughs one year of age or older that have been registered with the Foundation Stock Service, or that have been granted an ILP, are eligible to enter in Lure Coursing Tests and may participate in Lure Coursing Trials on an Exhibition-Only basis. Breed disqualifications apply.

## RIBBONS

Evergreen Basenji Club will offer:

**TEST:** Qualifying Course = Green Ribbon  
**TRIAL:** Rosettes: First = Blue, Second = Red, Third = Yellow, Fourth = White,  
Fifth = Pink, Best of Breed = Purple/Gold.

## TROPHIES

Trophies will be offered for **Best of Breed** and **Best in Field**.

## STAKES OFFERED

**JUNIOR COURSER TEST:** Open to all hounds of an eligible breed. A hound running alone shall receive a certification from a Judge on one date and a second certification from a different Judge at a later date, stating that the hound completed a six hundred (600) yard course with a minimum of four (4) turns. The hound must complete the course with enthusiasm and without interruption.

**\*\*\*IT IS RECOMMENDED THAT JUNIOR COURSER HOUNDS ENTERING THE OPEN STAKE FOR THE FIRST TIME HAVE SUCCESSFUL PRACTICE EXPERIENCE WITH OTHER HOUNDS BEFORE COMPETING.\*\*\***

**OPEN:** Open to all hounds of an eligible breed that have attained at least one of the following: AKC Junior Coursing Title, or AKC Field Championship Title. Hounds that are disqualified (or dismissed twice within six (6) trials) from Lure Trials may not be entered.

**OPEN VETERAN:** Open to all hounds that are eligible to enter Open or Special Stakes and meet the age requirement for a veteran as established by the breed's parent club.

Championship points will be awarded.

**SPECIALS:** Open to all hounds of an eligible breed that are eligible to enter the Open Stake and have earned their AKC Field Champion Title. Specials may compete for LCX points.

**BEST IN FIELD WILL BE OFFERED:** All Best of Breed winners, **with the exception of Italian Greyhounds**, shall be eligible to compete in the Best in Field competition.

## GENERAL

1. All entries must be one year of age or older on the day of the trial.
2. Stakes shall be split each time the entry is sufficient to hold two or more five point majors.
3. All hounds will run alone in the Test. In the Trial, all hounds will run twice, in trios if possible, or braces, unless excused, dismissed, or disqualified.
4. Hounds not present at the time of roll call will be scratched after a five (5) minute grace period. Each entry will be examined at inspection for breed disqualifications, bitches in season, and lame hounds, which will be excused and their entry fees refunded. Spayed or neutered hounds without breed disqualifications may be entered.
5. Battery powered **continuous loop** machines will be used. Lure will consist of white plastic bags. Backup equipment will be available.
6. The course will be reversed for the finals and run-offs.
7. The field committee reserves the right to alter the course plan as required by weather and/or field conditions on the day of the trial.
8. **THE FIELD COMMITTEE RESERVES THE RIGHT TO BAR KNOWN AGGRESSIVE HOUNDS FROM THE TRIAL SITE.**
9. **THERE WILL BE A \$5.00 FINE ASSESSED FOR ANY LOOSE HOUND NOT TAKING PART IN THE COURSE IN PROGRESS, OR FOR ANYONE NOT PICKING UP AFTER THEIR OWN DOG(S). ALL TRASH, INCLUDING DOG FECES, MUST BE HAULED AWAY BY THE OWNER.**
10. **PLEASE BRING YOUR OWN SHADE AND WATER.**
11. **NO ONE, EXCEPT FIELD COMMITTEE, WILL BE ALLOWED ON THE FIELD WITHOUT EXPRESS PERMISSION OF THE FIELD CHAIRMAN.**
12. Anyone exhibiting unsportsmanlike conduct will be excused from the field for the day.
13. No cigarette smoking permitted on this working farm field.

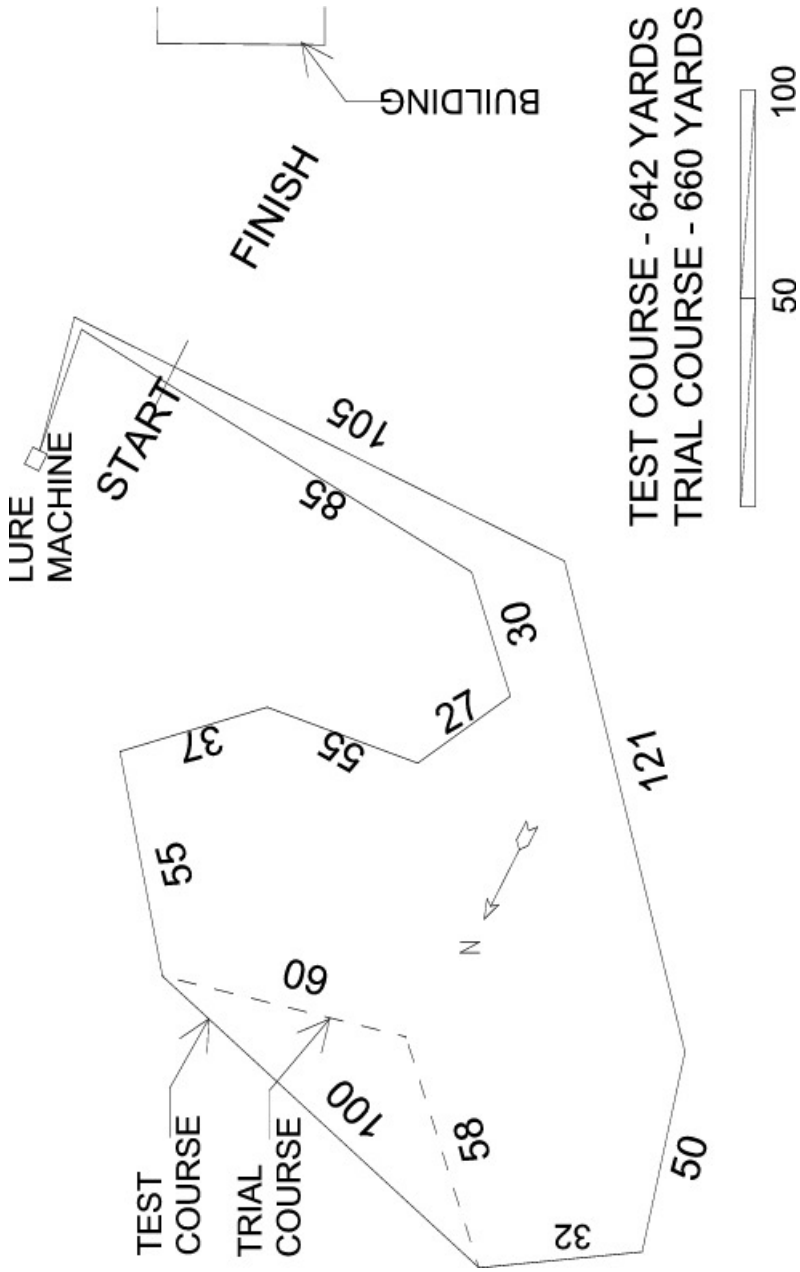
